Trial Hours:

Check-in for dogs belonging to the field committee will begin 30 minutes before published trial hours.

“Day of” TEST entries close at 8:00 am, Roll Call at 8:15 am and Draw at 8:30 am. “Day of” TRIAL entries will be taken until the conclusion of the test runs, with Roll Call and Draw beginning immediately after entries close.

E-mail entries will be accepted, payment can be made via PayPal or Venmo for an additional \$2 fee per entry.

Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own bye dog for QC runs.

Entries will not be acknowledged by mail or telephone. Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted.

General Information:

Hounds must be one year or older on the day of the test/trial. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Spayed or neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Any hound that displays aggressive behavior during trial hours will be excused for the day. A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.

There are restrooms on site. Bring your own food, water and shade. No littering. Pick up after your dogs. There will be a fine for NOT cleaning up after your hounds. RV parking is available, electrical hookups are available from \$20-\$30 per night depending on the amperage. Due to the proximity of neighbors to the parking area, dogs may not be off leash except when competing.

Due to COVID safety concerns, all exhibitors may be asked to wear a mask and practice safe social distancing guidelines as laid out by the American Kennel Club for performance events. Any exhibitor or participant who shows any sign of illness prior to or during the event will be asked to leave the trial site, and their entry fees will be refunded in full. Any exhibitor or participant unable or unwilling to adhere to the safety guidelines will be asked to leave the trial site.

List of Breeds Eligible to Enter:

AKC recognized breeds that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the AKC or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered. Breed disqualifications apply. Eligible breeds are: Afghan Hound, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco dell Etna, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Sloughi and Whippet.

FSS breeds may compete for suffix titles only: Portuguese Podengos (Medio & Grande), and Thai Ridgeback.

Note: FSS breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

Tests Offered:

Junior Courser – Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound at least 12 months of age running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard (minimum) course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete that course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Qualified Courser – This certificate is required to enter a hound in the Open Stake. A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. Print two copies of the attached certification form and bring them to the trial. After your dog successfully completes the course, have the judge sign BOTH copies. You will need to submit one copy with the entry forms and AKC papers the first time you enter your dog in a lure coursing trial. Keep the second copy for your records.

Stakes Offered:

Open – Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the ASFA or the CKC. ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Hounds that are disqualified (or dismissed twice within six trials) from field trials may not be entered.

Special – Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.

Veteran – Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, and Whippets and Rhodesian Ridgebacks= 7 years.

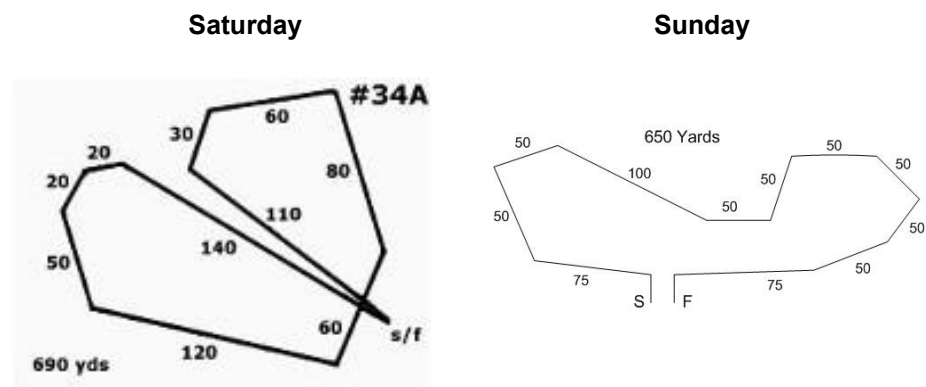
USRCC will offer a ribbon to each hound completing a qualifying run toward their Junior Courser or Qualified Courser title.

Course Plans

Saturday's course is 690 yards, Sunday's course is 650 yards, direction reversed for Finals. BOB and BIF start shall be at the judges' discretion. Terrain is mowed grass polo field. Battery powered continuous loop machine will be used and backup equipment will be available. Lure will consist of white and/or black plastic strips.

Hounds need to be in top physical condition due to the high elevation.

USRCC reserves the right to alter the course diagram as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
